Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Sai Ayurved College, Hospital and Research Centre, at Gat No.67, Sasure-Vairag, Dhengale - Patil Nagar, Solapur – Barshi Highway, Tal-Barshi, Solapur, Maharashtra with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18– reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. F.No.R-12011/09/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 09.12.2016 related to establishment of new Ayurveda College from the session 2016-17 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for 2nd professional course.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 27-28.04.2017 & 06.06.2017 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the requisite number of plants species in herbal garden and constructed area of Dravyaguna department are not available as per prescribed norms. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 30.08.2017 to present the case.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM, submission of the college and observations of Hearing Committee have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017 and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria for granting conditional permission.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission to the Sai Ayurved College, Hospital and Research Centre, at Gat No.67, Sasure-Vairag, Dhengale - Patil Nagar, Solapur-Barshi Highway, Tal-Barshi, Solapur, Maharashtra with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970**, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19 onwards:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda) and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2018-19.
